A reminder to coaches to adhere to rules #9, #12, and # 17.

There will be a \$30 fee per participant for this tournament. This fee will be given to the tournament chairman on the day of the tournament - May 19th - at the coaches meeting. ONLY CASH OR CHECKS (payable to the Cornell Univ. Golf Course) WILL BE ACCEPTED.

Any golfer from Section IV who meets the qualifying standards is eligible to participate. The first round of this 36 hole qualifier will be played on May 19th. The low 20 plus ties will return on May 21st to determine the nine medalists. All ties will played off on May 21st.

- * All matches played are to be listed, then indicate the throw outs
- * A golfer must have played in at least 50% of the school's regularly scheduled matches
- * Under 10 matches, throw out 1 score - 10 matches or more, throw out 2 scores
- * Championship and tournament rounds are not to be included

*** A golfer then must have a stroke average of +5 or under ***

**SECTION IV GOLF
RULES & REGULATIONS**

1. Coaches and Athletic Directors must certify that each golfer or team has met the qualifying standards. Failure to report correct data will result in disqualification.
2. A maximum of six golfers (one full team) from any one school may participate, with the five best scores counting towards the team total.
3. Coaches or other spectators will not be allowed to caddie or aid in any way during the course of play. Spectators or parents may not walk with competitors during play. Spectators or parents shall not be within close proximity of the competition and shall not communicate with them during play. (Penalty - disqualification from tournament.)
4. Ties occurring in the school team competition will be broken in this way: The first hole of all five golfers will be added up and the team with the lowest total strokes will be the winner. If still tied, additional hole or holes shall be totaled.
5. Ties for the medalist score will be decided on a sudden-death playoff.
6. No starting times will be adjusted for other activities on the day of the tournament. If problems, they can be taken care of prior to the tournament.
7. Any player using unsportsmanlike conduct can be disqualified from the competition.
8. All playoffs for medalist will be held after the completion of the tournament.
9. All golf coaches are to make themselves readily available to the chairman during the tournament. You are requested not to play golf unless cleared by the chairman and course pro. Anyone supervising another school's golfer should have written permission from that school, and let the tournament director know at least 48 hours before the event.
10. The rules of the USGA will be in effect as modified by the local scorecard and below:
 - a. All out-of-bounds are stroke and distance penalties.
 - b. The golf chairman and club professionals will determine on the day of the tournament if preferred lies are permissible. If so, the ball may be moved, on your own fairway only, by hand only, six inches or less, no nearer the hole.
11. If there is a dispute about a rule in your group, play a second ball under 3-3 (keep both scores) and have it settled by the tournament director before signing scorecards. Scorecards are not official until signed and attested.
12. At all Section IV golf events, participants will not be allowed to use their own vehicles without permission of the coordinator.
13. Any golfer leaving the golf course and not finishing the round for reasons other than an emergency or injury can disqualify himself and/or his school from future Section IV golf tournaments.
14. Each school district is legally responsible for the safety and actions of the golfers representing them.

15. Once a competitor begins play, he or she may not be replaced by a substitute for that round for any reason.
16. There will be no coaching of the competitors either by coaches or other spectators during the course of play.
17. Competitors and coaches are required to abide by the following dress code:

Proper Dress:

- a. a collared shirt
- b. dress slacks or trousers
- c. golf shoes or sneakers
- d. dress shorts or walking shorts
(no longer than knee level)

Not allowed:

- a. gym shorts, jean shorts and cut-offs
- b. tee shirts
- c. muscle shirts
- d. tank tops
- e. jeans
- f. pants which are ripped, torn, or patched
- g. any clothing deemed obscene or offensive

VIOLATION OF ONE OR MORE OF THESE RULES COULD MEAN "INDIVIDUAL" OR "TEAM" DISQUALIFICATION.
