## 2011 Boys' Tennis Sectional Rules of Play

1. Any player wishing to play in Section 4 competition must have played at least 6 matches during the regular season.
2. All players who enter this tournament must be willing to play in the state qualifier tournament on May 28 and 29, followed by the State Tournament the following Thursday through Saturday without default for any reason other than medical.
3. We use NO ADD scoring in all rounds. Best two out of three sets with a 12 point tiebreak. Players change ends after the first game of each set without the usual 90 second changeover time. The 90 second changeover time starts after the 3rd game. We then switch sides after each ODD game. Two minutes between sets 1 and 2, and then up to 10 minutes between sets 2 and 3.
4. Coaching is permitted only on the 90 second changeover time, or at the end of a set. Only one coach per team may talk to the players.
5. No player may play more than 3 matches in one day. Both semi finals must be played on the same day. Finals and third place matches must be played on the same day, and should be done on the first day if all involved have not already played 3 times. The site chair will determine if there is enough sunlight to finish matches on any given day.
6. Sometimes it is convenient to have the second day of the tournament finished at an alternate site if the players involved are all from the same area not near the original site. The site chair will have the final say as to how that should be handled. A later starting time is possible if all school involved agree to the later start.
7. We expect all participants to follow the rules of tennis. It remains the responsibility of each coach to ensure his/her players are competing in good faith and with sportsmanship in mind. Coaches are the only people that should be within 15 feet of the perimeter of the courts.
8. Coaches should bring one can of tennis balls for each team entry into the tournament. The winners keep the unopened can and will use that can in their next match. Please report scores immediately after the match to the tournament desk.
9. NYSPHSAA has a NO JEWELRY rule. That means absolutely no jewelry. Medical ID's are the only exception.
10. In case of inclement weather, please bring roll-drys with you. We cannot quit just because of a little rain.

## 2011 Boys' Tennis Sectional Rules of Play

11. Coaches should be aware of the progress of each of their player's matches. 90 seconds between games is not a long time and players will NOT be able to wait until the coach finally gets to their court. The coach will have to wait until the next changeover to talk to his/her players.
12. Injury time out is 3 minutes. This rule has some gray area as we all know. Cramping during a match is now considered an injury. If the player cannot resume play after a 3 minute injury timeout, a warning, then a point, then a game, then the match will be forfeited.
13. There will be a minimum of 25 minutes granted between matches.
14. Team scoring

Because of the small field of schools in Class A, all entries should begin with 3 points. Class CD tournaments should stop at the finals, and all final players will meet indoors at BTC for the East/West playoff the following Tuesday, where semi winners get 6 points and champions get 7 points.

15. At the end of EACH day the site chair should contact appropriate media with results. It's always easier to fax or email the results if possible.

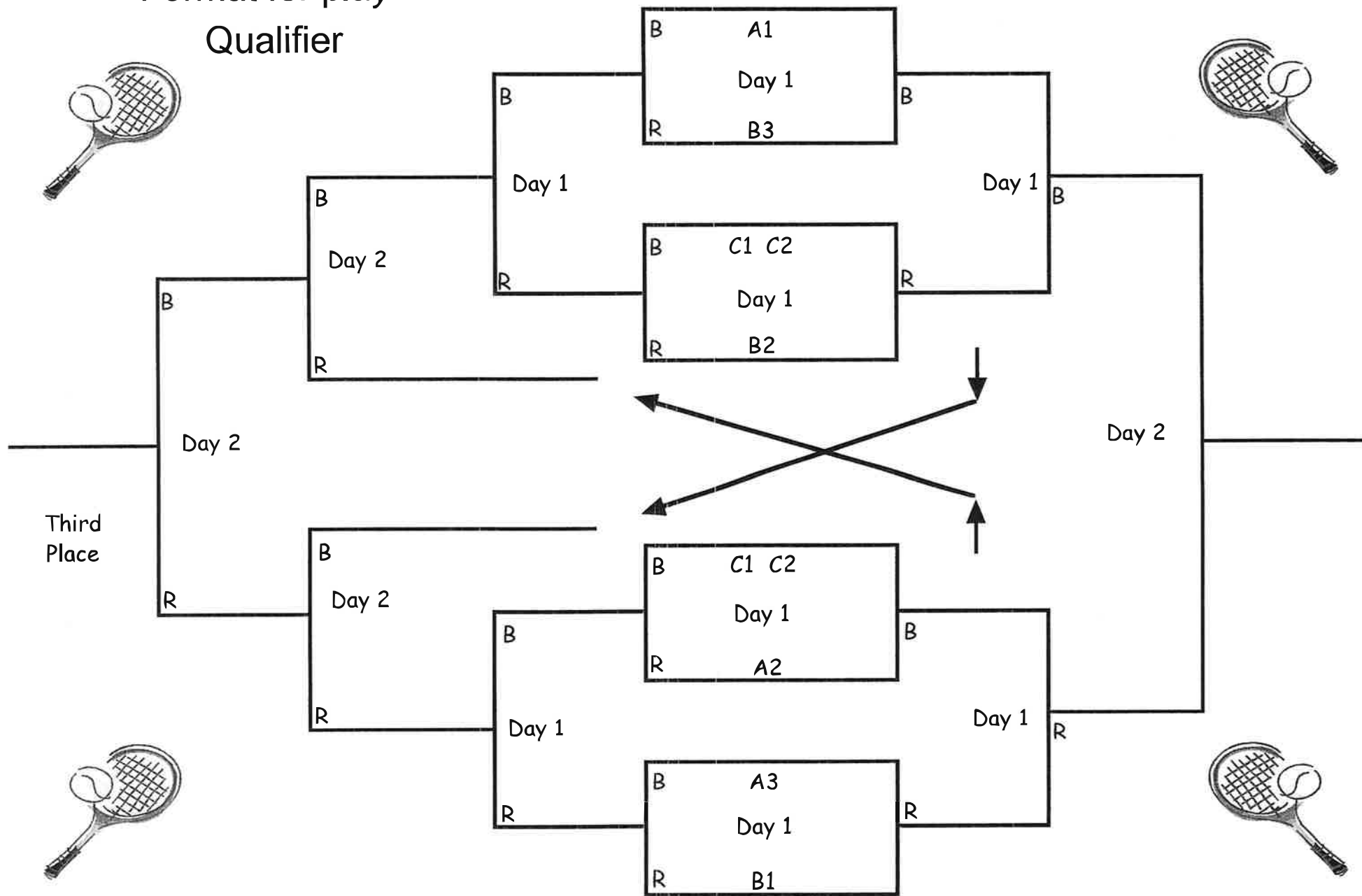

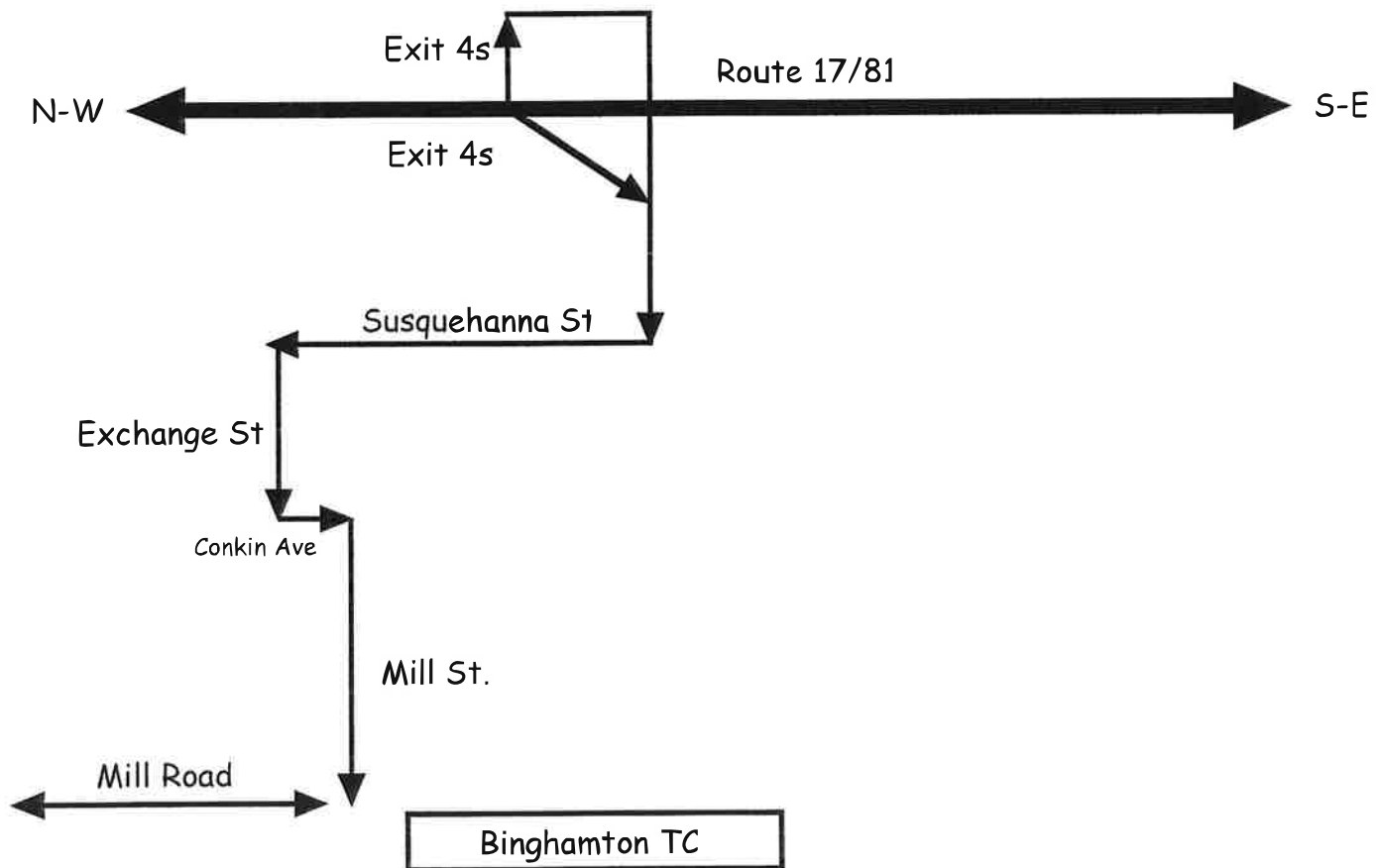
# Format for play Qualifier

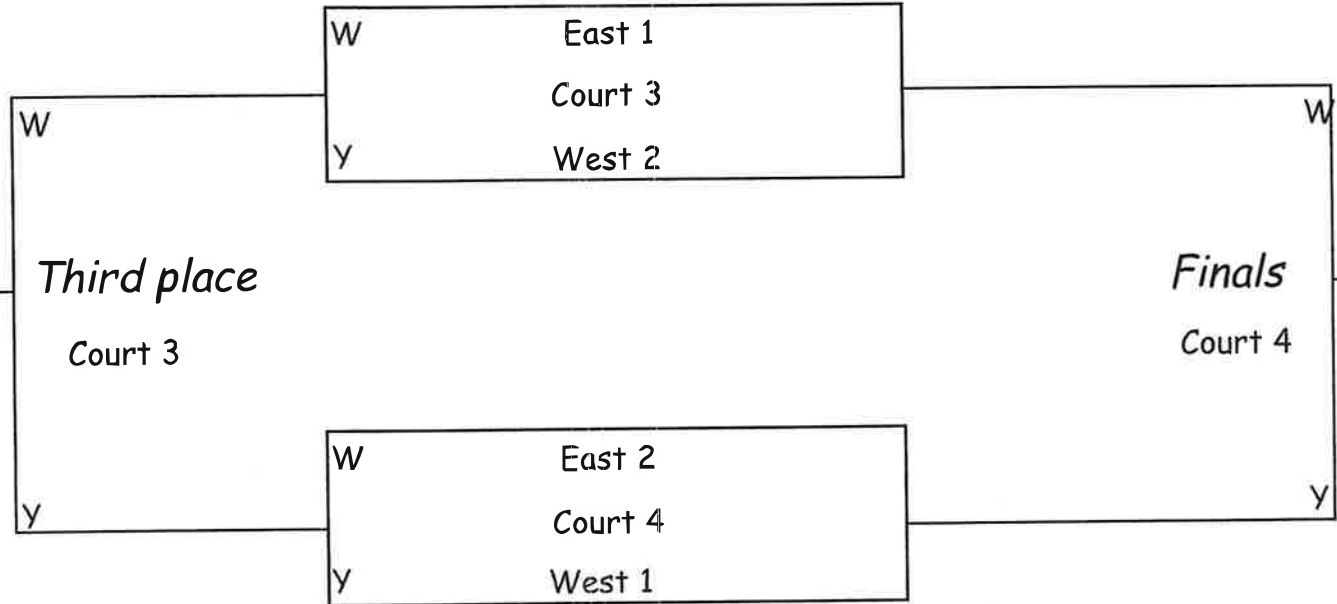

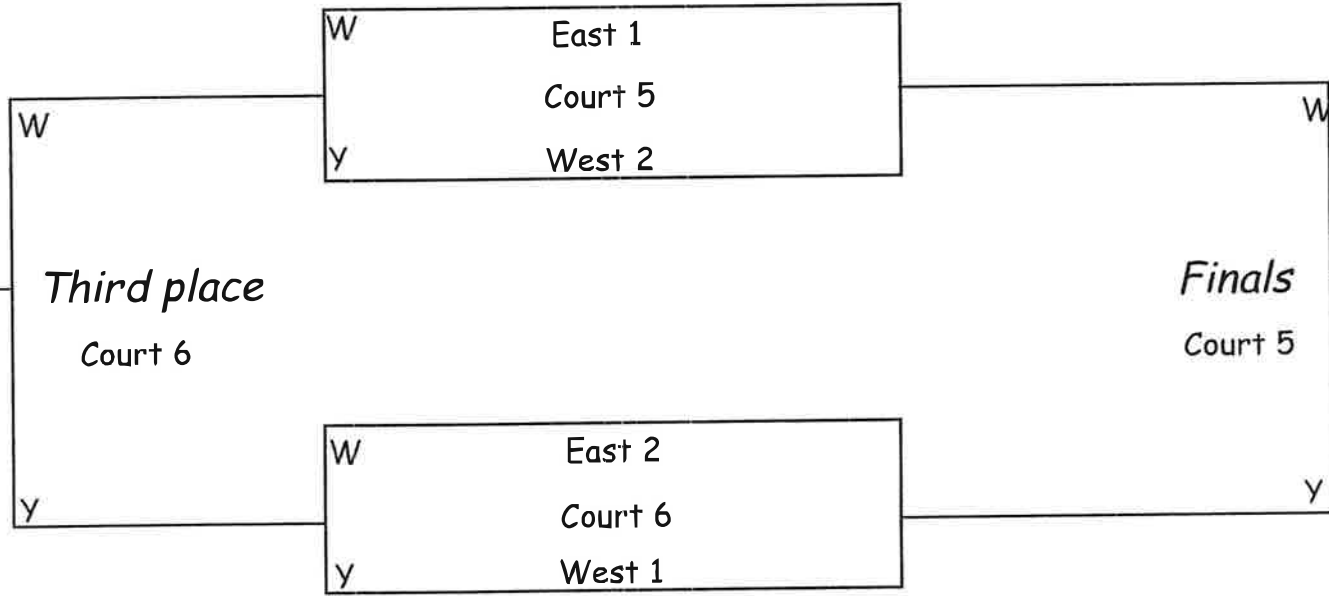

# Section 4 State Qualifier

## May 27-28, 2011

Coach's meeting at 9:30. This will start on time even if you are not here. Players' meeting to follow. We will use the last 4 courts. Viewing can be done on the bleachers between courts 4 and 5. Crowd control and rude fans are becoming a concern. If things get out of hand during play I will have no choice but to remove the option of on-court viewing. All fans will have to move into the lobby area for the remainder of the tournament. That decision will be made entirely by the tournament director. Nothing should interfere with match play.

Play starts at 10:00am. Coaches must bring 2 cans of tennis balls for each entry. 25 minutes rest between rounds. All sectional rules apply. You may **NOT** practice on any of the inside courts before or between matches. We will have two roving USTA umpires. Players are still responsible for calling their own lines. Coaching will be on court and only between sets for **2 minutes**. If the players split sets they may get up to **5 minutes** rest before the third set and they may leave the court. Only one Board of Education coach is allowed per school. No one else may coach the player(s) or go on the court.

If you are going to the States make sure you have **TWO** documents filled out and signed by the parents. Players will not be able to play in the State Tournament without those two documents signed. If you're coming back Saturday, get the papers on **FRIDAY!**
