Code of Conduct

For Athletes Including Cheerleaders

1. There will be no use of any form of alcoholic beverages.
2. There will be no use of tobacco products permitted.
3. There will be no use of drugs in any form unless prescribed by a physician.
4. All curfews and bed checks will be adhered to as set up by the supervisor or coach in charge.
5. Athletes are responsible for their conduct in regard to public property such as: Hotel rooms, transporting vehicles, field and courts, locker rooms, etc. Athletes or the school that they represent will be held financially responsible for any damage that they incur.
 - a. Hotel rooms will be inspected by the supervisor and the occupants of each room prior to the occupying of each room and again before check-out. Any damage incurred will be the responsibility of the occupants.
6. Athletes must use transportation authorized by their section and school.
7. There will be no gambling of any kind.
